

# New Me Cards

### Introduction

This engaging speaking activity helps students practice giving personal information and asking for personal information.

#### **Before the Lesson**

Print (A4 size) the two pages as many times needed for the amount of students you have. Cut out the "New Me" cards on the dotted cut lines.

## In the Lesson

Give each student a "New Me" card. They should fill-out the cards with their own personal information, or make a new persona for themselves.

On the board, create a list of questions they can ask for getting to know someone (referencing the type of information on the cards) and sentence starters for answering these questions. Ask for the students' input to see what they already know.

Then hand out the "Roleplay: At a Party" worksheet. Explain to the students that they are at a party and they don't know anyone. They must talk to at least three people and ask for personal information to fill-in their table. They also need to give their information to the other people.

When everyone has completed their worksheets, go around the room and have each student talk about at least one of the guests they met, more if the class size is smaller.
